ABOUT US: Nederland Miners' Days™ to benefit the Nederland Area Historical Society is a weekend of mining competitions and activities for men, women, and children to relive and celebrate the industry that helped to settle Colorado and which today continues to provide minerals for a growing national economy. This event, expected to draw upwards of 3,000 people, was established in 1916 and has continued to this day. We invite you as crafts and food vendors to apply to exhibit and sell your wares on Saturday, July 26 and Sunday, July 27, 2008.

ELIGIBILITY: All vendors are welcome to apply. However, we are especially seeking those who directly relate to the mineral industry such as jewelers or silversmiths; and those whose craft reflects the history of the West such as leather workers, stone and woodcarvers. Yet, we are open to all vendors. We ask that you submit a photo that shows the type and kind of items that you will be selling. Please send this with your application and fee payment. Also include any pertinent information about yourself and your work techniques that might be appropriate for publicity releases. Food vendors must meet state health standards as specified under **Regulations**.

Space is limited. Applications will be considered on a first-come basis. The Miners' Days™ committee reserves the right to make final decisions on vendor selection and booth location.

BOOTH SPACE: All booths are 10 X 10 outdoor spaces. Vendors must supply their own canopies, tables, chairs, and a trash receptacle for their use. Booths must conform to size restrictions and not infringe on a neighboring space or restricted area. If you set up in the wrong space, you will be asked to move. Some spaces may be on somewhat unlevel ground. You may want to bring shims for leveling. Come prepared! Mountain weather can change rapidly. Come ready to enjoy warm sunshine, but throw in tie-downs and rain covers in case an unexpected storm rolls off the peaks.

Food Vendors only: Water and electricity may be available on a limited basis and your need must be indicated on the **application form**.

BOOTH FEES: Booths are available for the entire weekend for \$100. A check in that amount must accompany your application. If your application is not accepted, your check will be returned. Please enclose a self-addressed, stamped envelope for our reply. Once your application is accepted, there will be ***no refunds for cancellations!***

CALENDAR:

- ❖ July 27 Miners' DaysTM Competitions. Booths open 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM

REGULATIONS:

Sales Tax: Each vendor must have in his/her possession a valid Colorado Special Event Sales Tax License and must register the license number with the Miners' DayTM Committee at the time of booth application. The licensee is obligated to collect all applicable state and local (Boulder County and Nederland City) sales taxes and remit the money to the Colorado Department of Revenue.

Food Vendors: All food vendors must hold a current Colorado Retail Food License for Special Events and must provide the license number as well as your sales tax number to the event coordinator. You also must complete an **Application to Conduct A Temporary Event Food Facility Form** to be turned in to the event coordinator no later than July 10 with your application. Each food booth must have an adequate hand washing facility.
